This contract is between a Northwest ISD Agriculture Engineering pathway department and the following Agriculture Engineering pathway student:

Building a project for show purposes is part of the educational experience of an Agriculture Engineering pathway student. Therefore, as the Agriculture Engineering pathway student, I will be the one who will be constructing this project. Others may assist me in preparation or holding materials in place, but I will be the sole person constructing this project. If someone else constructs any portion of this project, then I will not be allowed to exhibit this project at any shows attended by the Northwest ISD Chapters. In the event that it is discovered that someone else constructed the project at a show, show officials will be made aware of this and the student project will be disqualified and all entry fees will be forfeited.

By signing, I accept full responsibility for construction.

This project must be completed by _____ in order for me to participate in any shows this year. As an Agriculture Pathway advisor, I will check progress on this project from time to time. The project must meet the quality standards set by Northwest ISD in order to be exhibited at any show under Northwest ISD. Students and their families must understand the estimate given by the Agriculture Engineer pathway Advisor is only a rough estimate of the amount/cost of materials needed for the project. This cost may change due to the varying markets and or changes in the design. Parents and students/ sponsor shall understand the project is constructed by students of Northwest ISD and therefore, understand that Northwest ISD staff shall be released from all liability or warranty from project after delivery is accepted.

Students and their families will be responsible for the following:

- Cost of all materials needed for the construction of the project.
- Responsible for acquisition of appropriate designated show attire.
- Completion of the project.
- Maintaining a passing grade average.
- Students are required to build a portfolio during the construction of the project.
- Transportation arrangements for getting their project to shows.
- If constructing a project at the school shop, students/family must arrange to have materials delivered before or after school.
- Students and Guardians are required to provide their own transportation, lodging, and meals.

- If constructing a project at the school shop, students may be required to work before or after school depending on the size and scope of the project.
- Students will be required to complete their project by the assigned date _____, set forth by the Agriculture Engineering pathway advisor.
- Students are required to adhere to the policies and procedures of the handbook and NISD.
- Students/families will make arrangements to store projects off school sites once they are completed.
- When working on the project after or before school or on weekends (weekends in limited circumstances), students will adhere to the conduct code policies set forth by the Northwest ISD. This also includes while attending shows.
- An understanding that some projects may be outside the scope and abilities of students and advisors
